

Cookies policy

To make this user account centre work properly, we sometimes place small data files called cookies on your device. By continuing to browse this website, you agree to the use of cookies.

What are cookies? A cookie is a small text file that a website saves on your computer or mobile device when you visit the site. It enables the website to remember your actions and preferences (such as login, language, font size and other display preferences) over a period of time, so you don't have to keep re-entering them whenever you come back to the site or browse from one page to another.

How do we use cookies? We use cookies that can perform the following functions as defined by the Commission for the protection of privacy in its [recommendation n° 01/2015 of the 4th February 2015](#).

- Login and authentication as a registered member:
By banning these essential cookies to login or registration, certain central functions may not be accessible. These cookies are disabled by the browser when it is closed.
- Security information user-centric:
The storage of these essential cookies to login or registration is limited to the duration of the session.
- Site optimization statistics:
The statistical analyses relate to anonymous data.
- Audience statistics or site visit of orgine statistics :
The statistics are anonymous and based solely on the own cookies to the user account center and that meet this feature.

How to control cookies?

You can control and/or delete cookies as you wish – for details, see aboutcookies.org. You can delete all cookies that are already on your computer and you can set most browsers to prevent them from being placed. If you do this, however, you may have to manually adjust some preferences every time you visit a site and some services and functionalities may not work.
